Simply say one should worship guru, obey the guru, remember guru, chant guru's name all the time within, with heart and soul in order to lead a successful life





It is Guru-Bhakti Yoga. This Yoga is marvelous. Its power is tremendous. Its efficacy is most unfailing. The true glory Of Guru-Bhakti is indescribable. It is the Yoga par excellence for this age, which makes God appear here before you in flesh and blood and move with you in this very life. The hard Rajasic ego is the arch enemy of the Sadhaka. Guru-Bhakti Yoga is the surest and best Sadhana to destroy arrogance and to dissolve the vicious ego. Just as a particular deadly germ can be annihilated only by a certain specific chemical germicide, even so, to destroy Avidya and Ahankara, this unique Guru-Bhakti Yoga is the peerless specific. They are the gravest 'Mayacide' and 'egocide'. They become quite powerless and no longer afflict the fortunate soul who saturates himself with the spirit of Guru-Bhakti Yoga. Blessed indeed is the man who earnestly takes to this Yoga; for he will obtain crowning success in all other Yoga. TO him will accrue the choicest fruits of perfection in Karma, Bhakti, Dhyana and Jnana.

The qualification for taking to this Yoga is the simple trio of sincerity, faith and obedience. Be sincere in your aspiration for Perfection. Be not vague or half-hearted. Then have perfect faith in the one you have accepted as your Guru. Do not allow even so much as a shadow of doubt to approach you. When once you have reposed absolute faith in him, then know that what he instructs you is indeed for your highest good. Therefore, obey his word implicitly. Follow his teachings to the letter. Be earnest in doing thus, and take my word: you will attain Perfection; I assure you emphatically.

Salutations and worshipful Pranams to the sacred lotus-Feet of the Guru whose form is to be an object of our meditation, whose feet are to be adored, whose words are most holy truths and whose Grace grants us supreme Divine beatitude! Guru is one who shad destroyed his mind and who knows how one has to destroy it. The only thing that stands in the way of our spiritual realization is our own mind and it is to remove this obstacle that one comes to the Guru and surrenders himself unto him. But, then, Guru-Kripa has not only to be bestowed, not only to be given; it has also to be received. In receiving it, we immortalize ourselves, divinise ourselves. We must be ready to receive it; then it will flow into us and raise us to the highest realm of immortality, eternal light and infinite bliss. But, then, how can we receive it? How should we conduct ourselves if we are to receive this Grace?

Carry out the teachings of the Guru; and this should be our Sadhana day in day out. There may be certain inner qualifications which are necessary for the full and effective reception of divine grace; even after having attained all the qualifications of the ideal disciple, we have to wait in humility and in patience. There is no loss here, for the goal is immortal life, freedom. If we have become willing servants and willing, obedient disciples, then it is the natural law that Guru-Kripa may come in an unpleasant form. It may come in the form of a series of disappointments. We may think that Guru has not bestowed his Kripa upon us; but that disappointment itself will be his Kripa. We are not fit to judge whether we are ready to receive Guru-Kripa or not, and what form it would take. The best thing is to humbly leave everything to the Guru.

"I do not know whether I am a disciple or not. Therefore, O ocean of mercy and compassion, pray make me a proper disciple. Generate in me that Mumukshutva which makes me a disciple and give me the spirit of willing obedience.

"Help me in trying to follow thy instructions. Help me in trying to mould myself upon the pattern set up by thee"; this must be our constant prayer. And, by this alone shall we be able to draw the Kripa of our Guru and make our life fruitful. And the perfect way of praying is trying our best to be real disciples.

Worship is the means of approaching the Invisible. It takes us closer to the Intangible Divine Essence in which form Gurudev now abides after setting aside the physical in which He dwelt, and through which He moved with us all on a physical plane. By regular worship, the seeker strengthens his spiritual bond with the Guru even beyond the time of his physical existence. By preserving such a bond, the disciple is able to draw upon himself the continued Guru-Kripa. He is blessed with guidance and protected by His benedictions in a mysterious way. Adore thy Guru and pay homage unto Him who has opened thy eyes to the glorious purpose of life, and who has shown you the true path to blessedness and bliss. This is your foremost duty now. O Seeker after Peace and Joy! Herein lied thy Supreme Welfare.

The most holy Guru Purnima is a great annual occasion that provides you an invaluable opportunity of re-establishing this vital inner contact with Gurudev. 
Hostel

Jagannath is lord Vishnu and ancient temple in the city of puri in Orissa in India is famous for this unique chariot-pulling festival in which millions of devotees gather in this city and pull the chariot which as per world record one of the largest and oldest chariot procession in the world. Paying respects to lord Jagannatha same day same time same festival is conducted in all over India many cities and abroad too by the devotees of this tradition.



As per religious believes Lord Jagannath is taken out on a rath yatra and taken to famous Gundicha temple where lord rests for seven days. After this return journey of lord Jagannath begins .

Gurupoornima Message:



My salutations and prostrations to Almighty Lord and all the Gurus.

There is a great saint, Maharshi Vedavyasa, who is believed to be the incarnation of God. He was born 3000 years before the birth of Jesus Christ. According to the Hindu Calendar, Maharshi Vedavyasa's birth took place at the time of Asada Suklapakshya and full moon day. This is called Gurupoornima Day. Vedavyasaji wrote the Vedanta philosophy including the Sri Bhagavadgita, Upanishads, Brahma Sutra, 18 Puranas and Mahabharata, which are the foundations of Hindu philosophy. It is believed that on this full moon day, He taught his first lessons to His disciples, saints and sages for four months (Chaturmaas). As a respect to the memory of this great Saint and his teachings, every year we celebrate Gurupoornima Day.

Additionally, directly after Gautama Buddha reached Nirvana 2500 years ago, Buddha came to Saranatha and advised for the first time his 5 disciples on this auspicious Gurupoornima Day.

Usually a question comes, who is Guru? Adi Shankaracharya has written को बा गुरर्यो हि हितोपदेष्टा, a Guru is one who only gives advice for our salvation and realization. कृष्णं बंदे जगद्गुरूम, Almighty Lord is the Guru on the whole universe.

The Holy scripture -सत् सास्त्र

Realized saint. ----- संत

Our own pure intellect - बिबेक

is regarded as our Guru.

In occasion of Guru Poornima Day, the disciples worship their own Guru. Most of the disciples go to the feet of their Guru and give service, practice their sadhana with direct supervision from their Guru and receive blessings. During Chaturmasya is usually the time of heavy rain. The sanyasi and monks stop their traveling and stay in one place and spend their time contemplating and meditating.
