Bhakti By Swami Sivananda

Make use of this precious human birth for the achievement of this supreme purpose-God-Realisation. Pray to the Lord to make you desireless. But have one strong desire and let it be for attaining Self-Realisation. Through a life of devotion, service, purification, charity, sadhana (spiritual practice) and meditation attain the highest Self-Realisation and dwell in the supreme peace and bliss (Paramananda).

Devotion is supreme love of the Lord, supreme attachment to the Lord. The notion of God means an absolutely perfect being, who has all the possible attributes, including the attribute of existence; so, God must exist. The existence of God cannot be proved by rational arguments. It is purely a question of faith and refers to the intuitive side of man.

The deepest craving, the deepest aspiration in man is for eternal happiness, eternal knowledge and eternal truth. Man should search for some supernatural entity which can satisfy his deepest aspirations.

As we explain everything within nature by the law of cause and effect, so also the nature as a whole must be explained. It must have some cause. This cause must be different from the effect. It must be some supernatural entity, i.e. God. Nature is not a mere chance collection of events, a mere jumble of accidents, but an orderly affair. The planets move regularly in their orbits, seeds grow into trees regularly. Seasons succeed each other in order. Now, nature cannot order itself. It requires the existence of an intelligent being, i.e. God, who is responsible for it.

Everything in nature has some purpose. It fulfils some function or other. Certainly, every object by itself cannot choose a function for itself. Their different functions ought to have been planned or designed by a single intelligent being or God. You cannot explore or probe into the Lila (sportive play) of God. You must accept it with faith and reverence.

What is the nature of God?

God is love and love is God.

God is the source for this world, body, mind, prana and senses.

God gives light to the mind, sun, moon and stars.

God is your only redeemer, refuge.

God is your real father, mother, guru, friend and relative.

God is the only reality.


God is the dispenser of fruits of actions.

God is the designer and architect of the universe.

God is immanent and transcendent.

The Glory Of Sannyasa By Swami Chidananda

We, as seekers of Truth, have first of all to bear in mind that there is a twofold aspect in which Sannyasa pervades our life. In its purely spiritual aspect, Sannyasa embodies the highest spirit of Nivritti, viz., the total negation of names and forms, and the masterful and purposeful assertion of the One Reality, beyond all names and forms, Brahman or the Self. This is the highest outcome of the highest Vedantic Sadhana. This is the innermost core of the culture of Bharatavarsha, the highest and the only aim of human existence according to the Hindu genius. Not only this physical universe, but the countless number of universes that exist as a drop in the infinite ocean of Satchidananda, are negated in order to ever remain immersed in the blissful consciousness of the Atman.

To realise this great end and aim, our ancient sages and saints have interwoven and blended into the fabric of our social life the four Ashramas, viz., Brahmacharya, Grihastha, Vanaprastha and Sannyasa, to effect a gradual unfoldment of this spirit stage by stage in the life of an individual. In the Brahmacharya Ashrama or the student-life one has to live with his Guru, give up all distracting thoughts and give himself up completely to the study of scriptures, living a life of self-control, purity, simplicity, austerity, attention to studies and obedience to and service of the preceptor. In the next stage, he lives an ideal life of a householder, with selflessness, self-sacrifice and self-effacement as his mottoes. This is the preparation for the next stage, viz., Vanaprastha, where he has to discipline himself to enter the life of Sannyasa.

In the Sannyasa life, meditation and collecting food for his livelihood were the Dharmas enjoined upon the man who had done all his duties to society, to the nation, to his own family and to his friends. He has now no more attachment and has but to fulfil the one great duty, i.e., of meditation upon the Self, and realisation. Thus, in the last stage of the social order, viz., Sannyasa, we have the highest spirit which embodies the soul's upsurge from finitude to infinitude. This is the natural and dynamic movement of every soul which strives to break all finite bonds and cast aside all traces of attachment; and, completely shattering the illusion of duality and phenomenal existence, it strives to soar into the splendour of Atman-consciousness.

This innate urge of the individual is the spiritual aspect of Sannyasa for which no social order exists. It depends upon the intensity of the soul's urge, upon the thirst for Self-realisation which seizes the Jiva that has been awakened to the transient nature of the phenomena and to the ever-present Reality that is its very nature.

The real meaning and the true glory of Sannyasa can be best understood by devoutly observing saints and men of God who are the living embodiments of the highest and the best in Sannyasa. They personify Sannyasa in the truest sense of the term. Gurudev Sri Swami Sivanandaji Maharaj is verily the greatest exemplar of the true Sannyasa spirit. Every act of his is the illuminating revealer of the secrets of real renunciation.

Healthcare Activities

The current running departments of Sivanand Dharmarth Chikitsalay are General OPD, Eye, Dental, Physiotherapy, Pathology Lab, Ayurveda, Homeopathy, Veterinary and Ambulance Services for referral or emergency cases.

Panchakarma department is functioning well for male and female. The Tele Medicine facility having connectivity with AIIMS Rishikesh serves many chronic patients.

The Entire Dispensary works on HIMS (Hospital Information Management System) helping in maintenance of Electronic Medical Record, Pharmacy stock & Issue details and quick generation of patient Data. This is the only hospital in the entire Uttarkashi region offering this automated service.

Every month regular mobile medical camps are organized in remote villages around the Uttarkashi for the welfare of the people staying in remote villages. Also, regular medical education is provided at schools.

The new cloud enabled touch screen Health ATM, with a capacity to conduct more than 50 types of tests, provides instant reports to patients through print outs, e-mail and SMS.

The whole medical services are based on selfless-service to the needy.

Swami Sivanand Seva Samiti conducts frequent free Eye camps. Doctors and specialists from India as well as abroad are involved in providing the necessary consultancy during the camps. All medical aids are distributed to the needy patients free of cost. These Eye camps are an endeavor from Swami Premanand ji on a Sewa ground towards welfare of rural communities around Uttarkashi hilly villages.

From 27th June 2024, under the skilled leadership of Dr. Chirag Bahuguna, MS (ophthalmology), a 3-day camp was conducted, which involved registration, screening, surgery, treatment such as prescription glasses and medications, health education and counselling.

Timely follow up was done and all the cases were found successful.

The students needing support are identified on the basis of their educational performance, family background and annual family income. They are provided educational support in terms of fees, school uniforms, school bags, books, stationary etc.



Sri Swami Atmananda Saraswati attained Maha-Samadhi on 24th of June



Born in Karnataka, India on Feb 19, 1941; his pre-monastic name was Srivatsa. He was the youngest of two brothers and three sisters.

During his final year at the Bangalore Engineering College, in 1959, there was an All-India Divine Life Conference. Srivatsa's spiritual samskaras were awakened; he met Swami Sivananda and began studying spiritual teachings. Srivatsa's professors pleaded with him to take the final exams, but his mind was already immersed in spiritual and devotional practices. Despite not preparing for the exams, he took the exams and succeeded with high honors.

As the exams were completed, a senior disciple of Swami Sivananda was travelling to Rishikesh. Srivatsa declared his intention to renounce the world and accompanied Swami Venkateshananda. He became deeply absorbed in sadhana and Vedantic scriptures. He was initiated, age 20, into the holy Sanyasa order in 1961 by Sri Swami Sivananda Saraswati, along with Swami Premananda Saraswati; and was given the name Swami Atmananda Saraswati. He later met a venerable saint, Swami Durgananda, with whom he studied sacred chants and rituals, until Swami Durgananda's Samadhi at age 103.

Swami Atmananda became chief priest of the Durga Mandir in Rishikesh. Swami Bhimasen and Pandarung helped him manage the mandir. In 1970, he had the opportunity to travel to the USA with an American devotee. He lived there until 2018 when, upon the insistence of Swami Premananda ji, he moved back to India, age 77, to the Sivananda Ashram in Uttarkashi (Himalayas).

He made friends and disciples wherever he went, teaching scriptures, mantras and meditation to whomever joined him. He taught classes at University of Colorado in 1973; was the central dedicated server at the Hindu Temple in Flushing, NY in the late 1970s; lived in New Jersey, New York, Minnesota (1997-2016), Colorado, Florida and California.

Swami Atmananda was a Sanskrit scholar; he had a deep knowledge of the ancient Vedantic scriptures. He could chant memorized scripture for hours, rarely needing to refer to printed text. He was frequently invited to speak at spiritual gatherings; a favorite place was the Sivananda Ashram in the Bahamas.

He was real Viswamitra (Universal friend) to one and all. He was real renunciate who had Nil Bank balance inspite of having so many friends all over the world.

He embodied a quiet spiritual fervor that was deep and steady. He focused his energy on the Divine Mother Durga.

His iconic exhortation was always: Jai Durge!

He attained Mahasamadhi at 3 AM on 24th June (Monday). The departing was really wonderful, the realized soul departed from his mortal coil in awareness and peace, with the name of the Divine Mother on his lips.

We hope and pray that through his Universal form, he will continue to inspire, guide and protect his countless devotees and disciples forever.

Teachings from Yoga Vasistha: World beyond Creation

Whatever we know, is perceived by the senses and understood by the mind. This world is nothing but the projection of the mind. The world is not true, as it is always changing.

But before creation there was only One, the Absolute. At that time mind was not created. So, whatever existed before creation, it is beyond our understanding. But we know, we have to believe that there was something before creation. There had to be 'one' because many comes from the multiplication of one. You only can see forward, as your eyes are looking that direction. You cannot see what is behind you. But you have to believe, and you know that there is something behind you. Also, you only can see one side of a coin at a time. But you know that its other side is also there.

Our existence is limited to our 5 sheets, 3 bodies, mind and prana. Whatever happened before their creation, we are not aware of it. We only can think in time and space and the 'one' is beyond time and space.

In the pre-creation state, there was only one, and it was perfectly clear and transparent, and it was dazzling and glowing, too. There was no movement, no distraction. Like when the clear air in the desert becomes dazzling, we see water but actually it's a mirage. This dazzling and glow create the problem. It is the reason for creation. It is the cause of the creation of space, time and conditions. We call this pre-creation state Hiranyagarbha, the cosmic egg. When the One seems to multiply due to the effect of the mirage, this is called the hatching of the cosmic egg.

The sound that is created when the cosmic egg is broken is nothing but the cosmic energy that is the vibration created by the unsteady state. So, the chattering is nothing but cosmic energy which is nature itself (prakriti). This energy was initially one wave and it multiplied. This first wave is the egg itself. When the egg was opened, a blast happened, this blast became an audible sound. As long as the egg did not open, the sound was not audible because there was no movement. Without movement, we can't hear anything. Because sound can reach our ears by movement. If it doesn't move, it doesn't get heard. The sound is there even if it can't be heard. Sound is nothing but a process, a vibrational process, which is just energy.

Energy starts from absolute steadiness and propagates by multiplication. The process begins, the energy starts manifesting, nature becomes perceptible, it becomes clearer and clearer, but at the same time it becomes more and more confusing. The thought-wave, which is the cosmic mind, becomes three: sattva, rajas and tamas, the creative, protective and destructive powers, or willpower, knowledge power, creative power, so it starts to become dazzling. Differences start to emerge, that's what makes different opinions. When one wave becomes many, the process begins (movement, change), steady becomes unsteady. Between the two there will be space, and the relation between two creates time.

Objects are created, space is created between them, differences are created, time is created. This is what we think of the pre-creation state using our only tool, our logic.

We see this world through our own eyes (viz. the five senses), but the "I" is constantly changing. The person of yesterday is different from the person of today. Anything I say or believe is true now but tomorrow I may perceive something differently. Not only does a person change with time, but every person is different. My world is different from yours.

The mind is a changing thing, what it sees is also changing, so not real. We have to introspect ourselves. We have to ask the question 'Who am I?'. If we reflect on this, desires disappear, differences disappear, only the Absolute One remains.
