Who is a Jivanmukta ? By Swami Sivananda

A Jivanmukta is a liberated sage. He is released even while living. He lives in the world, but he is not of the world. He always revels in the eternal bliss of the Supreme Self. He has no identification with the body and senses. Hence he has no idea of enjoyment or enjoyer when he exhausts the residue of his Prarabdha. He has no idea of action or agent. He roams about happily without attachment and egoism, with a balanced mind and an equal vision. His state is indescribable. He is Brahman Himself.

Not through matted locks, not through fiery lectures and erudition, not through the exhibition of miracles, does one attain perfection or knowledge of the Self. He in whom the two currents, Raga, Dvesha, egoism, lust and anger are destroyed in toto is ever happy and he is Brahman or liberated sage or Jivanmukta. A Jivanmukta or liberated sage is absolutely free from egoism, doubt, fear and grief. These are the four important signs that indicate that one has attained perfection.

For a Jivanmukta there is no distinction between a rogue and a saint, gold and stone, high and low, man and woman, man and animal, censure and praise, honour and dishonour.

A Jivanmukta is an ocean of mercy. He tries his level best to rescue the worldly-minded who are deeply immersed in the mire of misery. He guides the aspirants in the attainment of Brahma-Jnana, which leads to perfect freedom. His very presence is thrilling and inspiring.

There at the summit of the hill you can see now the Jivanmukta or a full-blown Yogi. He has climbed the stupendous heights through intense and constant struggle. He did severe, rigorous spiritual Sadhana. He did profound Nidhidhyasana (meditation). He spent sleepless nights. He kept long vigils on several halting stages. He persevered with patience and diligence. He surmounted many obstacles. He conquered despair, gloom and depression. He is a beacon light to the world now. Remember that he was also rotting in those days in the quagmire of Samsara like yourself. You can also ascend to that summit if only you will.

Effacement of Ego By Swami Chidananda

It is well to remember that Sattva, Rajas and Tamas have their own hooks that keep the Sadhaka back and prevent him from soaring into the realms transcendental. The Sattvic hook is the most subtle of all and therefore most difficult to discern and detect. There are three abodes of ego:

1) *The gross or the Tamasic ego:* It is completely demoniacal and makes the person always thinking and doing in negative way. It always keeps the person far from the Lord and from the divine qualities of peace and joy.

2) *The Rajasic ego:* It is due to delusion and attachment with the material world. The person becomes blind to reason, discrimination and the Goal of the life on account of his involvement in the worldly things, his bondages and 'my and mine' attitude. He is not as unhappy as the gross ego person. But he too loses the right path due to delusion.

3) *The subtle or Sattvic ego:* This is desirable and helpful in the early advent on the spiritual path, for the simple reason that it keeps us out of the Tamasic and Rajasic egos and their consequences, and puts us onto the right, the spiritual path. It is a good ground to start spiritual Sadhana. But howsoever Sattvic or subtle it becomes, it is the ego principle and it remains so. So, so long as even the most subtle ego exists, one cannot have God-realisation, the Divine Experience. Selflessness, compassion and sympathy for others are the foundations of the subtle ego.

A mystic has given it an analogy of a golden cage. Though it is pure gold, very valuable, it remains a cage. Some mystics use the analogy of the three types of handcuffs — iron, silver and gold. The gold handcuffs look very beautiful, yet they remain handcuffs. So, for the ultimate Experience, the Sattvic ego is also to be transcended.

Ultimately, you have to become Trigunatita, you have to transcend all the three attributes; till that you cannot have God-realisation. However, it is the Sattvaguna which brings you near that so you should take refuge in Sattvaguna to become firmly rooted into the spiritual ascent.

Healthcare Activities

The current running departments of Sivanand Dharmarth Chikitsalay are General OPD, Eye, Dental, Physiotherapy, Pathology Lab, Ayurveda, Homeopathy, Veterinary and Ambulance Services for referral or emergency cases. Due to covid-19 the mobile camp program is on hold.

Panchkarma building is functioning well for male and female. The Tele Medicine facility having connectivity with AIIMS Rishikesh serves many chronic patients.

During Corona lockdown only emergency cases were attended. From September first week the hospital started working regularly with all mandatory precautions.

The Entire Dispensary works on HIMS (Hospital Information Management System) helping in maintenance of Electronic Medical Record, Pharmacy stock & Issue details and quick generation of patient Data. This is the only hospital in the entire Uttarkashi region offering this automated service.

The whole medical services are based on selfless-service to the needy.

Deepavali

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Deepavali is a festival of lights and one of the major festivals celebrated by Hindus, Jains, Sikhs. The festival usually lasts five days and is celebrated during the Hindu lunisolar month Kartika (between mid-October and mid-November). One of the most popular festivals of Hinduism, Diwali symbolizes the spiritual "victory of light over darkness, good over evil, and knowledge over ignorance". The festival is widely associated with Lakshmi, goddess of prosperity, with many other regional traditions connecting the holiday to Sita and Rama, Vishnu, Krishna, Yama, Yami, Durga, Kali, Hanuman, Ganesha, Kubera, Dhanvantari, or Vishvakarman. Furthermore, it is, in some regions, a celebration of the day Rama returned to his kingdom Ayodhya with his wife Sita and his brother Lakshmana after defeating Ravana in Lanka and serving 14 years of exile.

Teachings from Yoga Vasistha

If The Magician reveals his trick never again can we be fooled by it. But, somehow we've managed to forget how a sleight of hand creates this apparent universe we perceive that obscures Truth. Irrespective, it matters not what you forgot, think or assume, for whether you know it or not....You are That. You cannot deny it. You are the Absolute Truth, whether you accept it or not is not something for you to worry about. You are part and parcel of this Universal Truth.

Adopting a 360 degree approach; we see that everybody knows whether they know something or not. Both the person knows. Therefore, in reality you always know, ignorance and knowledge are two unveiled poles of the same reality. Expanding this further, ignorance is not knowing and that ignorance is called darkness or forgetfulness. At night, when there is darkness, we do not know what there is, be it name or form. Then light comes and illumines the world of objects and this light is known as knowledge. This light is ever-present in every heart at all times, in all conditions. You are the Children of Light and the very light itself. Thou Art That, Tat Tvam Asi. The quintessential essence of the Vedas, concentrated into three words. The wise, keep quiet and enjoy the magic show.

But, our issue is this...we are forever playing a bizarre game of hideand-seek with ourselves, within ourselves. Our mind cannot grasp the Absolute changeless, formless Brahman without some support.



Therefore, we exist in a world of names and forms designed by the Creator so that they may serve as indicators to locate and then transcend Him. Running parallel, Sadhana makes the mind pure enough to hold the subtlest of vibrations and we gradually become established in the 'Witness state'. Whereby even this atomic individual-self becomes the object opposed to the subject. If one becomes established in the substratum of all in this state, one may enjoy existence being one with everything; time, space, conditions, names and forms. That person becomes the Self of all beings. This conviction should hold and then there's nothing more to worry about, no wins no losses, no today, tomorrow, inside, outside...nothing. Everything is one. One holds many within it .From the 'Substratum-Holder-Witness' point of view, that state is the holder of one many everything and from an expanded perspective it appears as a collection of many. Those established in this state are now identified with the whole universe; they say, let all beings be without suffering and let all the world's be happy. That Universal being does everything for everyone although he does nothing for itself and once this one-ness is experienced it may never be forgotten or rejected. Then and there resides Eternal Bliss. Gradually, one realises that this presence, i.e. the Witness, is the Ring Master of the entire magic show. It is the Ring Master's presence that engages all to do something, He is the Supreme Master of Ceremonies, the Eternal Prompter. He does nothing. Is this not God? **Truth is Truth.**
