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Sadhana for Controlling the Ten Senses- By Swami Sivananda

Repression or suppression brings vehement reaction and the senses become formidable, turbulent and boisterous. What is wanted is sublimation of the senses through proper and good use but not repression or suppression. The senses must be thinned first through the practice of Pranayama. Vairagya (dispassion), Tyaga (renunciation), meditation, reduction of wants, control of desires help a long way in the control of the senses.

The senses are very strong and impetuous. They should be controlled gradually by intelligent methods, enquiry and discrimination. Violent Tamasic Tapas will not help much in their control. It is not a day's or month's work. It is a patient, continuous struggle. Plod on with patience and perseverance. Satsanga gives strength and helps to control them efficiently. Above all God's grace is very necessary. Obtain this through surrender, faith and devotion.

Jnana Indriyas(Organs of Sensation)

Control the ears by hearing the glories, the Lilas and Kirtans of the Lord, by hearing the Anahata sounds by the practice of Yoni Mudra.

Control the sense of touch by practice of Brahmacharya, sleeping on a coarse mat and wearing coarse blanket, coarse shirt and coarse clothes.

Practise Trataka daily and control the wandering eyes. Feel that every form is the form of the Lord. Put a stamp of the picture of the Lord in every form mentally. Do Trataka on your Ishta-Devata and visualise the picture with closed eyes.

Give up those articles which the mind likes best for a week or a month. Give up salt on Sundays. Take sugarless milk. Abandon pickles, chutni. Do not ask extra salt, or sugar for tea or milk. Take very simple, bland food. Eat three things. Fast on Ekadasi, Amavasya, Purnima, Janmashtami, Sivaratri, Vaikuntha Ekadasi and Dassera.

Karma Indriyas (Organs of Action)

Observe Mouna for two hours daily and 24 hours on Sundays. Speak measured words. Speak sweetly. Speak the Truth. You can control the organ of speech. Serve the sick and the poor. Serve your parents. Serve the Sadhus. Practise Ahimsa or non-injury in thought, word and deed. Do Archana or offer flowers to the Lord. Put up light in the temple. Sweep the floor in the temple. Bring water for Abhisheka. Do other services in the temple. Do charity. You can control the hand. Visit the temple. Visit the holy places of pilgrimage. Perambulate round the temple. Sit on one Asana for 2 or 3 hours. You can control the restlessness of the legs. Practise Brahmacharya. You can control the organ of generation. Eat moderately. Fast. You can control the anus.

Human birth, higher aspirations and the inspiration to contact great ones and to imbibe their stirring spiritual messages—all these constitute your wealth. All these constitute your good fortune. All these constitute your special unique blessings when compared to those who do not have these things.

Having been born as human beings, countless millions of people lead a life where their human potential is never fully recognised, never fully tapped and utilised. It is frittered and wasted away in miscellaneous petty pursuits and occupations. Thus, even though rich, they are poor. Even though most fortunate, they are the most unfortunate of beings. For they fail to recognise their good fortune and fail to put this great good fortune to proper use, wisely.

However, recognising our good fortune, let us try to see what we can do upon the constructive, positive side in order to build up a source of energy that will constitute an asset to ourselves and a fort out of which we can trap the living waters of a dynamic, progressive life, and what we can do in order to build up such a reserve of energy. It will not be possible to dwell upon all the things that we can do, but even dwelling upon a few of them will be, as it were, a finger pointing in the direction to follow.

A great deal of good will accrue to that human individual who makes up one's mind that henceforward I will always look upon the brighter side of things and never for a moment continue the habit of looking on the darker side of things. In short, be optimistic. Never say, I cannot do it. Never say, this is not possible. Never say, this is never meant to happen to a wretched person like me.

Who are you to say what is meant to happen to you, what is not meant to happen to you, when there is some higher Power that looks after and governs the life of all beings? Who are you to jump to conclusions as though you have made a window into His omniscience? You are trying to take a higher position: "He knows everything. I know what He knows."

This is a sort of mentality by which we become our own enemy. Instead of that, why not be positive? Why not say, "Everything is happening for my evolution. I am sure that only good can come out of it. Why? Because I know that the Supreme Being is all-goodness. How do I know? All the saints have said so. All the wise people have said it. All the scriptures of the world say that. He is all-auspicious, all-blessed, the Supreme One, the great and glorious One. There is nothing negative in Him."

In that way, hundreds and thousands of saints that have come and blessed the earth by their life and teachings through millennia have sung His praises, sung His glories. These great ones have lauded the Supreme Being in unmistakable terms, and this not merely through sentiment or emotion. They have lauded the Supreme Being out of their own personal experience of that Being. Therefore, we can be absolutely sure that that Being is the most blessed one, all-auspicious, all-good. "Therefore, I would be perfectly right and safe if I base my life upon that assumption and proceed with living my life on that assumption."

The wise person gets rid of the past. They do not allow the past to be iron shackles and chains connected to a great ball of iron: "So what hope is there for me to move forward even one inch? I am cursed to be where I am and to languish and die." This is the view of the self-defeating, negative-thinking pessimist, who sees only problems everywhere, not knowing that the problem is here. We have transformed ourselves into one great big problem, the problem of the self.

Therefore, shatter this self-created dungeon of darkness and soar high into the brilliant, bright light of the sun of optimism. Hope is one of the things prized by the Christian faith—faith, hope and love. Hope springs from faith also. And you will be abundantly benefited by this alchemy of transferring your base from pessimism to optimism, transforming yourself from a negative-thinking, despairing pessimist to a positive-thinking, hopeful optimist, by which you throw the doors wide open for your ascent, success, progress and highest attainment.

Significance of Ganesha

Lord Ganesha represents OM or the Pranava. Pranava is the chief Mantra of the Hindus. Nothing can be done without uttering it. Hence the practice of invoking Lord Ganesha before beginning any rite or work. The two feet are His Jnana Sakti and Kriya Sakti. Lord Ganesha has the elephant-head as that is the one figure in nature which is of the form of Pranava.

Lord Ganesha is an embodiment of wisdom and bliss. He is the Lord of Brahmacharins. He is foremost amongst the celibates.

He is the Lord who removes all obstacles on the path of the spiritual aspirant, and bestows upon him worldly as well as spiritual success. Hence He is called Vigna Vinayaka. His Bija Akshara (root syllable) is *Gung*, pronounced to rhyme with the English word "sung". He is the Lord of harmony and peace.

Teachings from Yoga Vasistha : The Ultimate Renunciation



The nature of the living being is ego, from ego arises pride, from pride arises ambition. With the association of the object the ego and the company of the individual sparks the pride; The soul becomes egoistic of the object and becomes arrogant to the person. The enslavement of the object and the individual is the cause of sorrow for the egoistic and arrogant soul. As long as there is a different thing in front of the living entity, there will be objective ego. And as long as a person different from you is seen, there will be pride.

Pride is the cover for the ego. In the limited ego there is arrogant ambition. It confuses the slow-witted patients at the beginning and the end of the work of the thinkers, renouncers and gentlemen. The sweet-tempting intoxication of ambition subsides only when the soul crosses the boundary of the object and the individual and experiences the truth.

Whatever is done by the ego-power, its result assumes the form of an important attainment when it rises above materialacquisition. The stronger the pride in a man, the more he is concerned about the point of view of others. Praise as long as there is pride

And the feeling of anger and aversion towards blasphemy remains intact. It is only for the sake of satisfaction that human beings are climbing and slipping on the innumerable steps of ambition. He accepts many positions and titles with special effort only for the sake of ambition and renounces them for more and more. Behind country-caste-service, ambition itself is hidden in gross and subtle form.

A person receives the virtue of sitting on a high golden-throne just for the sake of honour. The second, being endowed with the best qualities, knowledge and ability, sits behind everyone and proves that I am not proud, he is unworthy.

Seeing sitting in place and considering them to be arrogant, people give high value. If the renouncer, the ascetic, the detached and the devotee have not the ambition to wear it before the disguise, austerity, detachment and devotion is not complete, then what is? Those men who have easily renounced Kanchan and Kamini, they are seen to be angry and hostile for arrogant ambitions. In an arrogant soul, sometimes the greed for limited importance grows so much that even after being possessed of virtue, he keeps threatening his own comrades with a demonic face, paints his hands with blood.

Most of the people are running here and there for ambition. The sadhana of the seekers, the renunciation of the renouncers, the renunciation of the sannyasis, the erudition of the wise, the detachment of the detached, the austerity of the ascetics, the nerdy-pure-discreet knowledge-power of the swans is very far for the fulfilment of ambition. Often a sage, a sannyasi or a detached person who has become an embodied form of renunciation does not wait so much for the ultimate peace or realization of God. As much as the noble or wealthy disciple is eager to get. Wise shrewd men detach themselves in honour and ambition by going in contact with nobles, kings and officials. To prove it, it takes the help of good tips. It does not seem fair to blame them for this act. As long as there is ego, there will always be hunger. As long as there is desire, there is ambition, the real self-conquest is the victory over man. Man's ambition is the reason for his salvation and ultimate movement. If there was no ambition, then man would have accepted everything according to independent standards within the limited, the progress of life would have stopped. Having honour and ambition is not unreasonable and harmful, it is unreasonable to become a victim by attaining limited honour or ambition.

Man's motion gets blocked by motion of mind. Having attained importance and taking pleasure in the mind is poor. To give up is generosity. With the object, the ego and the pride in front of the individual is proved, the meaning of speed, salvation and the ultimate movement is that the ego should leave the company of the ordinary object before and become the company of the object of divine quality and nature and the virtuous person by changing becomes worthy of respect before the person who has the divine nature, thereby increasing the divine wealth. Yes, this is salvation in motion. Surrendering the ego at the feet of God is the ultimate speed.

The culmination of the progress of the ego lies in being self-realized and the culmination of the ambition to be with God. The movement of the ego starts with the soul and gets absorbed in it. The movement of ambition begins with individual coincidence and gets absorbed in the sum of the essence. This is the attainment of ultimate peace and nirvana. For this accomplishment, respect and ambition are required in the beginning. But enjoying them is a hindrance, keep sacrificing their enjoyment

Renunciation is the ultimate perfection. Feeling of renunciation "Not being" is real renunciation.

Not being is the end of sadhana, self-realization or Self-conquering.
